

Mayor Fred Froehlich called the Regular Meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. on March 14, 2022 in the Council Chambers.

Members and guests sited the words to the Pledge of Allegiance.

In addition to Mayor Froehlich; Councilmembers: Mary Wels, Matthew Anthony, Thomas Rieke and Phil Radel were present. Others in attendance included Vanessa Drill and Lee Zion (*Ledger*).

The agenda was approved on a motion which was made M. Anthony, which was seconded by M. Wels, and which carried with all voting in favor.

The minutes of the Regular February 14, 2022 meeting and workshop of March 3, 2022 were approved on a motion which was made by M. Wels, which was seconded by T. Rieke, and which carried with all voting in favor.

The bills totaling \$66,091.76 were approved on a motion which was made by M. Wels, which was seconded by P. Radel and which carried with all voting in favor.

Tom Rieke noted that he attended a Joint Powers board meeting. It was noted the county had did a re-adjustment on the percentages that make up the assessments of the fire districts. The city of Nicollet original assessment was 24.01%, the corrected percentage for the city of Nicollet should be 26.834%. The city will need to pay an additional \$2,676.18 for the annual 2022 assessment which will be added to the city's portion for the new tanker which will be \$103,288.68.

Resolution #03-14-22- Designate the Polling Place for the 2022 was approved on a motion by M. Anthony, which was seconded by P. Radel, which carried with all voting in favor.

Resolution #03-14-22A – Closing of a Fund #304 was approved on a motion made by M. Wels, which was seconded by T. Rieke, which carried with all voting in favor.
