

Mayor Fred Froehlich called the Regular Meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. on August 8, 2022 in the Council Chambers.

Members and guests sited the words to the Pledge of Allegiance.

In addition to Mayor Froehlich; Councilmembers: Mary Wels, Matt Anthony, Thomas Rieke and Phil Radel were present. Others in attendance included Vanessa Drill, Dave Holcomb, Brad Pyan and Karen Fluegge (*Ledger*).

The agenda was approved on a motion which was made M. Wels, which was seconded by P. Radel, and which carried with all voting in favor.

The minutes of the regular July 11, 2022 meeting were approved on a motion which was made by M. Anthony, which was seconded by T. Rieke, and which carried with all voting in favor.

The bills totaling \$207,568.77 were approved on a motion which was made by F. Froehlich, which was seconded by M. Anthony and which carried with all voting in favor.

Brad Pyan, Commander, and Dave Holcomb, Adjutant, of the Nicollet American Legion was present to discuss Friendship Days. The Legion is looking for city and community support to continue with an annual celebration. A meeting will be held in September with organizations and the Legion would like a city representative present. The City clerk will attend the meeting.

The clerk presented a memorandum from the city attorney providing information on ways the city can potentially regulate the newly legalized products THC.

Directing the city attorney to create an interim ordinance temporarily prohibiting sales and distribution of certain THC products was approved on a motion which was made by M. Anthony, which was seconded by M. Wels and which carried with all voting in favor.

Permission for Trinity Lutheran Church to place an approach (curb cut) on Sixth Street for the new garage that will be built was approved on a motion which was made by M. Anthony, which was seconded by P. Radel, and which carried with all voting in favor.
