Truth and Taxation Hearing was set for Monday, December 12, 2022 at 6:00 pm which was approved on a motion made by M. Wels, which was seconded by T. Rieke, and which carried with all voting in favor.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:03 p.m. which was approved on a motion which was made by M. Anthony, which was seconded by P. Radel and which carried with all voting in favor.
