

Mayor Fred Froehlich called the Special Meeting to order at 12:00 p.m. on May 28, 2020 via teleconference.

In addition to Mayor Froehlich; Councilmembers: Matt Anthony and Tom Rieke were present. Councilmembers Mary Wels and Jim Anderson were absent. Others in attendance included Vanessa Drill.

The purpose of the special meeting was to issue an amendment to the Cabin Bar's liquor license to include the fenced in parking lot area north side of the building located at 620 3rd Street effective June 1, 2020.

Due to COVID-19 and the Governors orders this will allow the business to serve alcohol outside on the north side of the building. The business will be placing a fence around the area and this designated area will be included in the liquor liability insurance. The license will go in effect June 1, 2020 and expire June 30, 2020, then will be renewed with the annual liquor licenses.

Amendment to the JBF, Inc DBA Cabin Bar liquor license to include the fenced in parking lot area on the north side of the building located at 620 3rd Street, effective June 1, 2020 was approved on a motion which was made by T. Rieke, which was seconded by M. Anthony, and which carried with all voting in favor.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 12:03 p.m., which was approved on a motion made by T. Rieke, which was seconded by M. Anthony, and which carried with all voting in favor.
